Handy tips on how to paint an interior cement floor and which products to use.





Floors can add a special feature to your home. To repair or apply a new paint coat on a cement surface is easy to achieve.



## A coat of excellence

Check the floor for cracks and holes and apply **NEO** Bonding Liquid in all the cavities

> Apply **NEO Repair Paste** to the cracks and scrape off excess paste with a utility scraper.

Larger holes must be filled with 2mm layers until the cracks are filled.

Let each layer dry for 1 hour.

Use a small piece of 220 grit sandpaper to smooth the areas flush with surface.

Previously painted floors: Remove all loose peeling



Make sure the surface is dry, solid and free from dust, oil or chemicals.

Sweep the floor properly – do not wash with water.
